SESSION REVIEW First Session of Seventh Assembly (24.02.2020 to 26.02.2020)

SUMMONS

Summons for the First Session of the Seventh Legislative Assembly of National Capital Territory of Delhi were issued to the Hon'ble Members on 20.02.2020.

DURATION OF THE SESSION

The First Session of the Seventh Legislative Assembly commenced on 24 February, 2020 with observance of two minutes silence to mark the solemnity of the occasion and was adjourned *sine-die* by the Hon'ble Speaker on 26.02.2020 after holding three (03) sittings. The sittings were held on 24.02.2020, 25.02.2020, & 26.02.2020.

The Business conducted by the House during the First Session is summarized below.

OATH OR AFFIRMATION

Shri Shoaib Iqbal, the senior most Member of the House was appointed as the Speaker *pro tem* by the Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor. Shri Shoaib Iqbal took oath before the Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor on 24.02.2020.

The sitting of the House commenced at 2.00 PM on 24.02.2020 and was presided over by Shri Shoaib Iqbal, the Hon'ble Speaker *pro tem*. The Secretary, Legislative Assembly laid the copy of the notification regarding election of the Members on the Table. Thereafter the Hon'ble Members took Oath, signed the Roll of Members and assumed their seats.
