

**Subject: - Deletion of the names of electors from the electoral roll in case of "Shifting", "Demographic similar entries (DSEs)" and "Death"-regarding.**

References: - (1) Commission's letter No. 23/2021-ERS dated 2<sup>nd</sup> August, 2021,  
(2) Commission's letter No. 23/2021-ERS dated 13<sup>th</sup> August, 2021,  
(3) Commission's letter No. 23/2021-ERS dated 13<sup>th</sup> September, 2021,  
(4) Commission's letter No. 23/ID /2021-ERS dated 18<sup>th</sup> January, 2022, and  
(5) Commission's letter No. 23/INST/2022-ERS dated 14<sup>th</sup> November, 2022.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to state that detailed provisions for preparation of electoral rolls have been provided in the Representation of the People Act, 1950 and the Registration of Electors Rules, 1960. The Commission has been issuing instructions from time to time, supplementing the extant statutory provisions to ensure the process of revision/updation/preparation of electoral roll is undertaken and accomplished meticulously and in hassle-free manner. In supersession of all the instructions, under reference, which have been issued on deletion of entries from electoral roll, the Commission has decided to issue the following instructions for better comprehension, as these have been amalgamated and put at one place with slight amplification and modifications, wherever required.

2. Section 22 of Representation of the People Act 1950 provides the procedure of correction, which is reproduced below: -

*[22. Correction of entries in electoral rolls - If the electoral registration officer for a constituency, on application made to him or on his own motion, is satisfied after such inquiry as he thinks fit, that any entry in the electoral roll of the constituency-*

*(a) is erroneous or defective in any particular,*

*(b) should be transposed to another place in the roll on the ground that the person concerned has changed his place of ordinary residence within the constituency, or*

*(c) should be deleted on the ground that the person concerned is dead or has ceased to be ordinarily resident in the constituency or is otherwise not entitled to be registered in that roll, the electoral registration officer shall, subject to such general or special direction, if any, as may be given by the Election Commission in this behalf, amend, transpose or delete the entry [after proper verification of facts in such manner as may be prescribed];*



*Provided that before taking any action on any ground under clause (a) or clause (b) or any action under clause (c) on the ground that the person concerned has ceased to be ordinarily resident in the constituency or that he is otherwise not entitled to be registered in the electoral roll of that constituency, the electoral registration officer shall give the person concerned a reasonable opportunity of being heard in respect of the action proposed to be taken in relation to him [after proper verification of facts in such manner as may be prescribed].*

3. It is clear from the provision of Section 22 referred to above, that the ERO, either through a formal application or on his own motion can delete the name of an elector from electoral roll subject to his satisfaction. However, it is hereby clarified that presently on ERO-Net there is no option available for deletion of name of elector without Form-7. In each case of deletion of an entry, a Form-7 is either received/obtained from an elector/BLO or a Form -7 is generated by the system. The process of disposal of all Form-7, whether received/obtained from field/system generated is done by following the due procedure by giving notice and putting the same for mandatory 7 days' period.

4. It is obvious from the above that though as per laws, ERO has statutory power to delete an entry from electoral roll on his own motion, **subject to such general or special direction, if any given by the Election Commission in this behalf.** The Commission, taking all aspects into consideration, including with a view to obviate possibility of a wrongful deletion during election year, has directed that EROs shall not resort to a deletion without a Form 7 and without following due process of verification. Accordingly, the Commission, hereby issues the following directions on deletion of entries in electoral roll: -

5. Broadly, there are following three grounds for deletion of entries from electoral roll:

(i) **Multiple Entries (ME)** - These multiple Photo Similar Entries (PSE)/ Demographic Similar Entries (DSEs) are generated by the system or reported by individual /BLOs/political parties, in which the elector's particulars i.e. name, relation's name, relation type, age, gender and address, etc. are same or one or two entries are different.

(ii) **Shifted Electors:** (a) Cases where an elector applies for shifting of Residence/change of Address through Form-8, for addition at the new place by new ERO and simultaneous deletion of names from the previous place of registration by the previous ERO or (b) intimation of elector not residing at the given address may come from any source, including through Form-7.



(iii) **Dead electors:** (a) On the basis of Death certificate from competent authority or List of deceased electors collected from database of Registrar of Birth and Death, identity of deceased is established or (b) An application in Form-7 is received from field.

6. The normal SOP for deletion of entries from the electoral roll in the above-mentioned cases is as follows:-

- (i) Form 7 shall be obtained in each case of deletion. The ERO shall follow due procedure of verification before taking final decision in the matter.
- (ii) For removal of Multiple Entries/ Photo Similar Entries (PSE)/Demographic Similar Entries (DSEs), elector name shall be retained in one place as opted for by the elector (after giving notice in prescribed Format-A and obtaining his confirmation of present residence or EPIC number) and deleted from all other places in the Electoral Roll. Notice in Format-A must be sent by Registered Post with AD/Speed Post and after receiving reply necessary action will be taken by the ERO concerned. A period of 15 days starting from the date of issue of Notice will be provided to the elector for furnishing reply of the Notice via Confirmation letter. If no reply is received within 15 days then BLO will go to the address of the applicant and collect the confirmation letter from elector and do the necessary verification.
- (iii) For removal of name of permanently shifted elector, Notice in enclosed Format-B must be sent by Registered Post with AD or by Speed Post giving 15 days to respond. If Postal Department returns the Notice mentioning the person not found at the address given, or if the elector does not respond within the stipulated notice period, then, the ERO shall send BLO concerned for field verification. If the BLO also does not find the person residing at that address, then after expiry of 15 days' notice period, deletion may be done by ERO on the basis of BLO's report, without obtaining Form-7 from any elector though form-7 for deletion will be generated by the system, as explained above. If the elector responds back objecting to the deletion, then ERO shall conduct the hearing and dispose of Form-7, following due procedure. If the concern elector does not come for hearing ERO may go ahead and delete his name. However, if an elector has shifted only temporarily, but is otherwise ordinarily resident at the given address, his name shall not be deleted from the electoral roll of the constituency.



- (iv) For removal of name of a deceased person, field verification by BLO must be carried out and deletion of the name of deceased elector shall be done on the basis of Form-7 and field verification report from BLO concerned. The BLO report may be accompanied by Death certificate from the competent authority as submitted by family members/List of deceased electors collected from database of Registrar of Birth and Death. In all such cases the individual form will be displayed on ERO's notice board for prescribed 7 days' notice period and if the ERO is satisfied about the validity of objection in Form-7, he may allow it without further enquiry after expiry of 7 days' notice period. In case, he is not satisfied, he will give notice of hearing to the objector and to the person objected to either personally or by registered post or by affixing it at the person's residence. After enquiry into the objection in respect of the objection, ERO shall dispose of Form-7, following due procedure.

**7. Deletion in an election year**

- (i) As per Section 23 (3) of the RP Act, 1950 no amendment, addition or deletion shall be made in the electoral roll of a constituency, after the last date for making nominations for an election in that constituency and before the completion of that election. It is clear from the above, that addition, deletion and modification in roll is allowed up to the last date of making nominations. However, in the light of Rules 18 and 26 of RER, 1960, where a provision is made for mandatory seven days' notice period before disposal of any claims and objections, updation of only those forms can be done in electoral roll which have been received at least 10 days (seven days' notice period + three days for preparation of the list of addition/deletion/modification) before the last date of filing nominations.
- (ii) Further, the Commission, taking in view the practical difficulties for printing of an electoral roll updated on the basis of the supplements to be generated on the last date of making nomination by the EROs for conduct of election due to short time available with them for the purpose, has decided that no corrections of entries and deletion of names shall be done after 10<sup>th</sup> day of announcement of election programme, to enable EROs to print updated electoral roll up to that date. However, addition in electoral roll (through Form-6 in case of new registration or through Form-8 in case of shifting shall remain continue till the last date of making nominations, as there is no change in the mother roll due to such additions.



(iii) Accordingly, all Form-7, and all Form-8 for the purposes other than shifting of residence (within constituency/outside constituency), received after the date of announcement of election programme by the Election Commission shall be kept pending and will be taken up for disposal by EROs only after completion of election process in that constituency. As explained in the preceding paragraph, all Form-6 and Form-8 seeking shifting of address (within constituency/outside constituency) received 10 days before the last date of filing nominations in that constituency shall be disposed off after due process and names of eligible persons shall be added after the last entry of the part roll in chronological order on the last date of making nominations when the roll is frozen. The additions list containing all names entered into the ER database during the continuous updation period shall be appended to electoral roll already printed, for preparation of an electoral roll for elections.

(iv) It is further clarified that Form-8 in which change of address on the ground of shifting has been sought, shall be processed for addition at shifted place, however, no simultaneous action for deletion of such name at the old address shall be done by the respective ERO, instead, the name of such elector shall be put in ASD list. Specific instructions shall be given to the concerned polling team to check identity of such elector on the basis of his latest residence proof, if the person visits the polling station at the time of election. The process of simultaneous deletion of the names of electors who are listed in ASD list (due to their shifting and enrolment at new place) shall be started by the respective ERO of old place immediately after completion of election, after following the procedure already explained.


8. All the records, communications and responses relating to deletions shall be kept in the file (physical as well as in ERO-Net) separately for each of such electors whose names have been deleted, uploaded in ERO-Net for future reference for 3 years. Provision for this has been made in the ERO-Net.

9. For the purpose of monitoring of removal of shifted entries, DEOs shall submit a monthly report (generated through ERO-net) to their respective CEO by the 10<sup>th</sup> of the following month reflecting the assembly constituency wise figures of identified, confirmed and finally deleted cases. CEOs in turn, shall send a consolidated list of the same AC wise/District wise along with overall narrative progress report in the matter to the Commission by 15<sup>th</sup> of every month.



10. All notices (in the enclosed Format 'A' & 'B'), Checklist and the list of final deletions, may be generated through ERO-Net. A monitoring dashboard, for specific purpose of removal of shifted entries, has been provided on ERO-Net.
11. Wide publicity may be given about options available for person, whose name has been deleted from the electoral roll wrongfully. These options are that either he/she can file an appeal under Section 24 of the Representation of the People Act, 1950 within the prescribed period to the District Election Officer against the deletion of his/her name or submit a Form-6 before the Electoral Registration Officer for inclusion of his/her name in the electoral roll any time during summary revision or continuous updation of electoral roll.
12. All concerned may be informed accordingly.
