"Whereas in the absence of a fully empowered Legislative Assembly, the citizens of Delhi are deprived of their basic right of enacting necessary Legislation to meet their social and economic need through their elected representatives;

Whereas they are also deprived of an effective voice in vital matters like Land, Police, control over Services, Finance etc.;

Therefore, this House strongly recommends to the Central Government that Delhi be granted Statehood to safeguard the interest of the people in general".
