| 1. | 2.07 PM | <p>Prof. Vijay Kumar Malhotra, Leader of Opposition stated that the statement made by the Chief Minister outside the House regarding reducing in VAT on LPG is objectionable.</p> <p>Dr. Jagdish Mukhi and other BJP Members called it matter of Contempt of the House as the House was in Session.</p> <p>Members from the Ruling Party and Opposition Party stood up on their seats and started exchange of arguments.</p> |
| 2. | 2.09 PM | <p>The Chief Minister stated that no such statement was made by her.</p> <p>Members of Bhartiya Janta Party not satisfied with the reply of the Chief Minister, raised slogans.</p> |
| 3. | 2.19 PM | <p>The Chief Minister again categorically denied any statement or declaration on this issue. She only suggested this to the Finance Minister. She stated that many Members had given their suggestions regarding the proposals in the Budget, which will be considered when the Minister of Finance would finally give the reply to the discussion on Budget in the House.</p> |
| 4. | 2.21 PM | <p>The Chair delivered his ruling that ideally no statement should be given outside the House during the Session but the Chief Minister has already clarified that she had not made any such statement. Therefore, there is <i>no question of impropriety involved</i>.</p> <p>On the issue of Contempt of the House, Hon'ble Speaker stated that in the Practice & Procedure of Parliament by Kaul & Shakhder, it has been clearly mentioned that, "<i>No privilege of Parliament is involved if statements on matter of public interest are not first made in the House and are made outside.</i>"</p> |
